**Mini-grant Proposals**

UC San Diego honors the heritage, culture, and lives of Native Americans. As a result of the positive response to the California Native American Day Celebration inaugurated on September 28 and 29, 2006, the campus wishes to expand its programs to the UCSD community and actively engage participation in Native American issues during the months of September, October and November.

Mini-grants are available to UCSD campus organizations, departments and student groups in award amounts **up to \$1,000**. Proposals for programs, events, and activities such as, film screenings, creative performances, lectures, outreach or service projects addressing California or Native American subject matter will be considered. ***There are two deadlines for this process.*** The first deadline is for those wishing to hold their program at the start of the fall quarter. The second deadline is for those wishing to hold their event later in the quarter, before November 30. Please direct your attention to the appropriate deadline for your program. **REQUIREMENTS AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Deadline for programs scheduled for *early fall* is Monday, September 10.**  
Award notification will be communicated by Monday, September 17.
- 2. Deadline for programs scheduled for *late fall* is Monday, October 1.**  
Award notification will be communicated by Friday, October 5.
3. A complete proposal answering all of the points listed below must be submitted.
4. Organizations that receive funding will be required to submit an evaluative report following their event due by December 7.
5. Proposals that involve broad constituency (faculty, students, and staff) collaboration and planning are strongly encouraged and desired by the committee.
